



## **SFTS Caused by Tick in Ehime**

The government of Ehime prefecture announced that a male farmer in his 60's living in Uwajima was infected with SFTS (Severe Fever with Thrombocytopenia Syndrome) which had been transmitted by ticks.

In Ehime, the first patient was confirmed in February 2013, and the total number of patients has reached 23, including this case. Of the 23, eight of them have died.

The government says "To avoid the infection, the most important thing is to not be bitten by ticks. When you go into bush or wooded areas, please wear shirts with long sleeves, long pants and boots to cover your skin as much as possible. And also please be careful of ticks sticking on your dog.
