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The 23rd Niihama Global Party "Just One World"

Niihama's 23rd Global Party was held at Women's Plaza on February 17th with the theme of "Just One World". The weather was very fine and warm, so about 380 guests and organizers from 14 countries took part in it. The party started with Okinawa folk songs. Participants were able to meet people from different culture and eat a lot of various foreign sweets.

This time participants were able to experience special activities for the first time. People experienced an earthquake simulator, as well as a building smoke simulator and fire extinguisher. About one third of the participants tried and enjoyed these activities.

On stage there were Indonesian folk music and dance and then Mongolian Dance. Traditional Japanese Drum Performance and a skillful magic show were performed. People enjoyed Pressed-flower art, Origami, Copper Craftsmanship, Calligraphy and wearing Yukata and folk costumes. The party ended with the Bamboo Dance and everybody had a very good time.

A hint for your life

Some Foods Influences the Effect of Medicines.

You have to be careful about the combination of food and medicine because some of the combinations can do us harm.

Don't take antibiotics together with milk. Antibiotics can combine with the calcium in the milk to make it difficult for the stomach to absorb the antibiotic. Some sour fruit like oranges can dissolve some of the ingredients of antibiotics and make them less effective. Many of the drugs used to lower blood pressure are calcium channel blockers.

Similarly, when you eat grapefruit together with these drugs, blood pressure is likely to be lowered too excessively by the combined effect of the drug and grapefruit.
