(Foreign students told me that they couldn't do well at all on the reading test.)

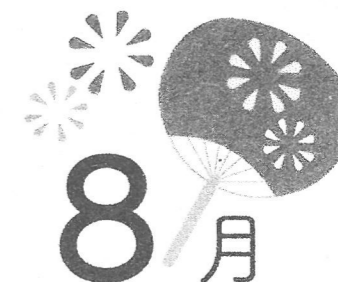

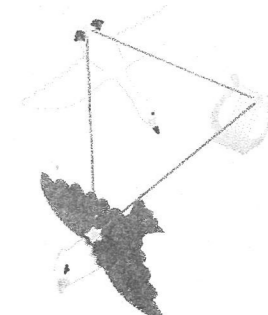
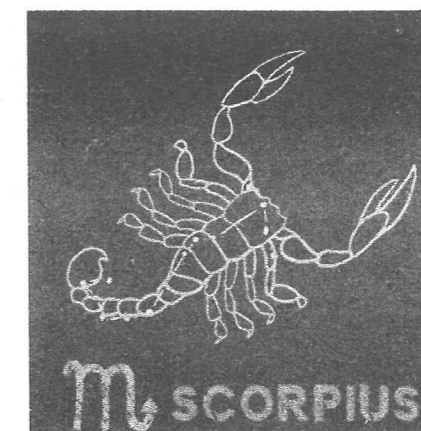

☆ Planetary at the Bunka Center ☆

At Shimin-Bunka-Center, Niihama Municipal Culture Center (Shigemoto-cho, Niihama), a planetarium projector has started to project Niihama's summer night sky. It is a hidden spot known only to those in the know. The fee is surprisingly inexpensive, from ¥10 to ¥60, so many people visit there frequently. You can enjoy the planetarium until August 31st this year.

Inside the planetarium decorated with paper flowers and stars, the staff in charge projects that night's sky to a narration recorded in 1974, when the planetarium opened. During the 45-minute showing, the Scorpion and the Summer Triangle are shown by switching manually. He sometimes adds some words to make it interesting.

This particular planetarium is an 'MS-8', a three-ball type optical planetarium produced by Minolta (nowadays KONICA MINOLTA Inc.) from 1971 to 1994. The company said that they had sold 29 projectors in Japan and 17 of them are still in use. It can project approximately 3,500 stars down to 5th magnitude stars.

Nanko Kimio (77), who has been in charge for 10 years, said, "Few people know there's a planetarium in the Center. This year we don't have many visitors because of COVID-19 but I hope many people come here and enjoy the planetarium."

How to reduce weather-related pain

When the weather is not good, don't you suffer from headache, dizziness or joint pain? Recently these symptoms caused by change in barometric pressure are called 'Weather-related pain'.

First, let's keep a record when and how you felt sluggish. If you record the condition of weather, pressure, exercises, or sleeping hours, you can grasp the relations between weather and health condition. You can also make use of mobile applications

People with sensitive inner ear tend to feel the pain, so it is recommended that they should massage their ears pulling upward, downward and horizontally for five seconds each. Stretching, aerobic exercise and warming your body in a bathtub are also recommendable. Why not give them a try!

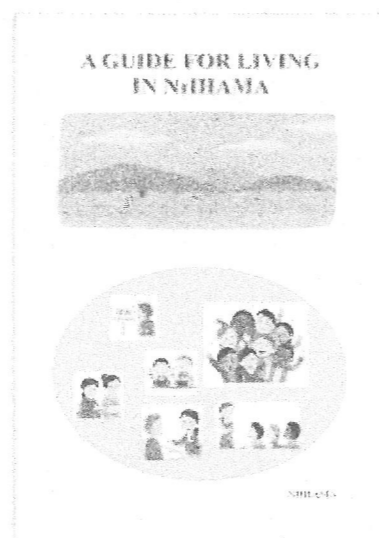

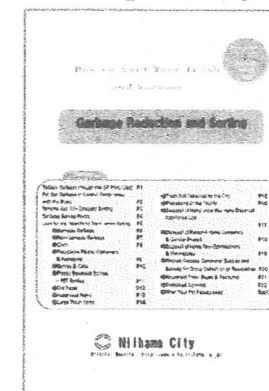
