『~やすいです、~にくいです』の 使い方

A:Bさん、スマートウォッチ 買ったんですか。

B·san, sumāto wotchi kattan desu ka? (B·san, did you buy a smart watch?)

B:ええ、いいでしょう? 最新モデルです。

Ē, ī deshō? Saishin moderu desu.

(Yes. It's great, isn't it? It's the latest model.)

A:わたしも 買おうかな。それ、<u>使いやすい</u>ですか。

Watashi mo kaō ka na? Sore, tsukaiyasui desu ka? (I wonder if I shoud buy one. Is it easy to use?)

B:機能は多いけど、操作は<u>わかりやすい</u>ですよ。

Kinō wa ōi kedo, sōsa wa wakariyasui desu yo.
(It has a lot of functions, but it's very easy to understand its operations.)

A:健康の ために、毎朝 野菜ジュースを 作って 飲んで います。

Kenkō no tameni, maiasa yasaijūsu o tsukutte nonde imasu. (I make vegetable juice to drink for my health every morning.)

Discrimination and COVID-19

(Ehime Shimbun: September 3, 2022)

It was reported last July that the number of new COVID-19 cases per a day reached 1,000 in Ehime. Soon after in August the number exceeded 3,000. There is no end in sight to the fight against this unknown virus. The hospital bed occupancy rate sharply rose and the Ehime Prefectural Government has declared a "BA.5 Medical State of Emergency." Now we are facing the biggest crisis since March 2020 when the first case of COVID-19 in Ehime was confirmed.

It may sound rather imprudent but I feel somewhat relieved concerning COVID-19. Society has begun to gradually accept COVID-19, saying things like "We should not blame others for being infected with the virus." However, just because we are defenseless in the face of the overwhelming number infected, it does not mean that we have overcome discrimination.

Infected people have been slandered and harassed repeatedly in Ehime. It might just be a cause of the fear of the virus, but I got chills down my spine when I heard the experiences of the victims. I thought, "How foolish human beings are!" and have tried seriously to keep fighting against the discrimination.

Now workers in my newspaper company are getting infected one after another day by day. When an infected reporter earnestly said to me, "I am very sorry to be infected. I am afraid that I might have infected someone in our company", I feel that he is suffering more mentally than physically.

A society where anyone can live happily is ideal. Anyone can be wholly treated without being blamed or discriminated against even if they get infected. I wonder how much closer we have come to "the blessed society of us" in the last two and a half years.

Furthermore, we sell animal figures under the name of "Real Animal". These are produced in the USA and imported by a trading company in Hyogo Prefecture that is the only importer in Japan. We are its sole agency."
